4.Repertoire:

Preliminary Round: Video Recording

Any Recording available on the Internet (**Preferable YOUTUBE**). Free Program of Max. 15 minutes in length.

Notification of acceptance to the Competition will be sent to all accepted competitors per E- Mail, by August 15, 2013, and will be announced at www.bcopen.de/participants

Final Round: (Live Performance)

Each accepted Participant will perform a program of maximum 15 minutes in length. The Programm of this round is free, can be repeated from the DVD Recording, and can be changed any time!!!

5. Jury: The Jury has a Right to stop the participant(s) any time during the performances.

The jury into equal parts can divide the prizes.

The members of the jury may also suggest not to give any reward if they deem that no candidate is worthy. However, the Final decision will be made by the Chairman.
